SECURITY PROCESS

For United States Citizens...

Upon entering the Volpe Center, you must pass through a security screening process. Please place your belongings on the conveyor belt and step through the magnetometer. Present your valid photo identification to the Protective Security Officer (PSO) operating the magnetometer and X-Ray machine.

Effective May 7, 2025, as a federal facility, the Volpe Center is subject to the <u>REAL ID Act of</u> <u>2005</u>. Our security staff CANNOT accept driver's licenses from non-compliant states and jurisdictions for entry into the facility. Please <u>review</u> the list prior to arrival. All identification presented must be valid (i.e., unexpired) to gain entrance.

<u>Enhanced drivers' licenses</u> are accepted from some states; these licenses have "<u>enhanced</u> <u>driver license</u>" prominently displayed at the top.

Visitors from any of the **non-compliant states or jurisdictions** will need an alternate form of identification (e.g., U.S. Passport or PIV card) to be permitted entry into Volpe. Foreign guests must use their passports.

Once you have been cleared by the screening process, proceed to the security desk, and give the Protective Security Officer (PSO) your valid photo identification (e.g., complaint license or passport) as well as the name of your escort. Volpe guests must remain with their escorts for the duration of their visit. You will receive a visitor's badge, which you must always display while onsite at the facility. Return your visitor badge and lanyard to the security desk at the end of your visit. You may not use the same visitor badge for a multi-day visit; proceed to the security desk to obtain a new visitor badge each day of your visit.



For non-U.S. Citizen Visitors...

International guests and non-U.S. citizens must be cleared for entry to the Volpe Center at least five business days ahead of the event or meeting.

Cleared foreign guests must proceed through the metal detector and bag check. After entering, proceed to the security desk to show identification, which may include:

- Border crossing card
- DHS trusted traveler cards (e.g., Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST)
- U.S. permanent resident card
- U.S. certificate of naturalization or certificate of citizenship
- Employment authorization document issued by DHS with photo
- U.S. refugee travel document or other travel document or evidence of immigration status issued by DHS containing a photo
- Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC)
- Merchant mariner credential issued by DHS
- Native American tribal photo ID
- Foreign government-issued passport
- Canadian provincial driver's license or Indian and Northern Affairs Canada card



BUILDING AMENITIES

The Volpe Center building is fully handicapped accessible. Visitors to the Volpe Center may access the following amenities while being escorted by their sponsor:

- Visitor bicycle and short-term vehicle parking
- Cafeteria dining room, sitting areas, collaboration areas, and electrical outlets for device charging (third floor)
- Store (operated by the Massachusetts Commission of the Blind) with snacks, beverages, and prepared food (first floor)
- ATM machine at the Transportation Federal Credit Union branch (first floor)
- Emergency Services from the Health Unit with an on-staff nurse (sixth floor)
- Private lactation room (sixth floor) (contact Kristen Benjamin, GSA, to make a reservation)
- Quiet Room (sixth floor; noise-free activities)
- Outdoor terraces (third and sixth floors)



DIRECTIONS TO THE VOLPE CENTER

BY RIDESHARE:

The approximate cost of a rideshare service from Logan Airport to Kendall Square, Cambridge, is \$35.00-\$40.00. Costs depend on traffic conditions and the time of arrival.

BY SUBWAY:

From Logan Airport via MBTA

- From Terminal A or E, take the Silver Line Waterfront SL1 service to South Station. Please visit the <u>MBTA</u> <u>website</u> for a detailed map and schedule information.
- **2.** At South Station, change to the Red Line MBTA train northbound (to Alewife).
- 3. Travel to Kendall Square/MIT stop.
- 4. Exit MBTA station and head northeast on Main St. toward Broadway, continue onto Third Street, turn left on Potter St., then arrive at the Center. Alternatively, once you arrive at the Kendall Square stop, you could go straight through the lobby of the Marriott hotel, then follow the path up the Loughrey Walkway.

From South Station via MBTA

- **1.** Take the MBTA Red Line northbound (to Alewife).
- 2. Travel to Kendall Square/MIT stop.
- 3. Exit MBTA station and head northeast on Main St. toward Broadway, continue onto Third Street, turn left on Potter St., then arrive at the Center. Alternatively, once you arrive at the Kendall Square stop, you could go straight through the lobby of the Marriott hotel, then follow the path up the Loughrey Walkway.

From North Station via MBTA

- **1.** Take the MBTA Green Line inbound to Park Street.
- **2.** Change to the Red Line northbound (to Alewife).
- 3. Travel to Kendall Square/MIT stop.
- 4. Exit MBTA station and head northeast on Main St. toward Broadway, continue onto Third Street, turn left on Potter St., then arrive at the Center. Alternatively, once you arrive at the Kendall Square stop, you could go straight through the lobby of the Marriott hotel, then follow the path up the Loughrey Walkway.

SUBWAY MAP


THE VOLPE CENTER IS LOCATED ON THE RED LINE AT KENDALL/MIT
